Bookings			
Stevedore labour bookings must be finalised by 1400hrs on the previous working day.			
Minimum Shift Lengths			
A minimum shift length of 4 hours applies to all mooring & unmooring operations (at applicable gang rate), unless continuous with stevedoring.			
A minimum shift length of 7 hours applies to all dedicated stevedoring gangs undertaking cargo work (at the applicable gang rate).			
Shared Labour			
Shared labour will be at the discretion of KPA and will be confirmed at the time of stevedoring booking. A 4 hour minimum shift length applies to all shared labour (at applicable gang rate).			
Stevedoring Labour Allocation and Cancellation			
a) Where the Customer cancels the associated Port visit after labour has been allocated, and KPA is required to cancel the rostered stevedoring labour, the Customer shall be liable to pay a minimum of four (4) hours per stevedore allocated, at the applicable rate for that shift.			
b) Where a shift is cancelled within two (2) hours of the scheduled commencement time, or at any time after the shift has commenced, and the shift involves a dedicated stevedoring gang undertaking cargo work, the Customer shall be liable to pay a minimum of seven (7) hours per stevedore allocated, at the applicable rate for that shift.			
c) Where a change to the scheduled shift start time occurs, labour cancellation charges may apply. In such circumstances, KPA will work with the Customer to determine the most economical and practical approach, recognising that different operational scenarios may apply.

Note 1: 'Revenue Tonne' (Freight Tonne) the greater of the weight in metric tonnes or volumetric measurement in cubic metres of the goods or cargo handled.	
Note 2: If KPA facilities or equipment are being hired or used "Per day" then the following paragraphs apply: (a) for the initial period of hire or use the minimum charge is the full "Per day" rate; and (b) if use or hire extends beyond 24 hours then a minimum charge of 50% of the full "Per day" rate will apply for each 12 hour increment or part thereof that the equipment or facilities are hired or used.	
Note 3: KPA reserves the right to allow port users to enter into special arrangements upon application.	
Note 4: Excludes ADF, Customs, Fisheries, fishing (<50m LOA), cruise (<50m LOA), pearling (<50m LOA), tourism charter (<50m LOA) and private non-commercial vessels (<50m LOA).	
Note 5: Per hour is applied as a minimum charge of 1.0 hour and charged in 0.5 hour increments thereafter.	
Note 6: KPA reserves the right to recoup expenses (on charges) at cost plus 15% (+ GST) administration fee.	
Note 7: Where a crane of the required capacity is unavailable and a larger crane is provided at KPA's discretion, charges may be applied at the rate of the smaller capacity crane.	
Note 8: All cargo lifted across the wharf onto or from a vessel, excluding vessel stores, shall be subject to a minimum wharfage charge.	
Additional charges: KPA reserves the right to introduce new fees & charges and adjust existing fees & charges by giving minimum 30 days written notice.
