DERBY – POST TC LUANA - DAMAGE TO JETTY

This Marine Notice supersedes LMN 03/2026 dated 29 January 2026

Mariners and port users are advised that the Port of Derby Jetty and Barge Loading Facility (BLF) sustained damage from Tropical Cyclone Luana.

Vessel traffic:

- The Derby Jetty has been assessed as safe for vessel berthing, and thus vessel traffic is permitted to resume as per normal process.
- Repairs have been undertaken at the lower barge ramp - LCT/Barges are permitted to use the lower barge ramp. Access to higher ramp is not permitted until repairs are completed.
- Mariners must maintain caution as the channel may have silted or shifted due to the recent disturbance.

Vehicular traffic:

- Repairs have been undertaken at the southern access road movement remain restricted.
- Northern access remains closed until further notice as repairs are pending.
